Dear Mrs. Fattorelli,

As President of the Hellenic Parliament I am in the process of establishing a Committee for the Audit of the Greek Debt and the Promotion of the International Cooperation of the Hellenic Parliament with the European Parliament, the Parliaments of other countries and other international organizations with respect to matters of state debt.

This Committee will operate within the framework and under the auspices of the Hellenic Parliament. The purpose of this Committee is to assess, after acquiring, processing and evaluating all relevant elements, data and documents, the part of the debt that may be deemed as illegal, illegitimate or odious. I will be personally chairing this Committee in my capacity as President of the Hellenic Parliament. Mrs. Sofia Sakorafa, Member of the European Parliament will be responsible for the relations with the European Parliament and the other European Parliaments. Dr. Eric Toussaint, Senior Lecturer at the University of Liège and a specialist in matters of illegitimate and illegal debt will coordinate the scientific work of the Committee and its international interdisciplinary team.

The first meeting of the Committee will be hosted in Athens, at the beginning of April. The first results of the work to be undertaken will be presented in an international Conference In June.

As you have done substantive work in these matters, we would be honoured if you accepted to put your services at the disposal of the Hellenic Parliament for such an important cause of national but also international importance. Given the nature of the cause, there can be no provision for any fee for the participation in this Committee, but the Hellenic Parliament will cover travel, accommodation and expenses for members of the Committee.
